

Postdoctoral Fellow

The Department of Mathematics seeks a Postdoctoral Fellow in actuarial science beginning in the Fall of 2010. Candidates will be expected to contribute to the research and teaching mission of the department's actuarial science program.

Minimum Qualifications: Candidates must have received a Ph.D. within the last four years and demonstrate evidence of excellent teaching ability and outstanding research potential. Preference will be given to candidates who have demonstrated progress towards professional actuarial certification and whose research interests intersect those of the permanent faculty in actuarial science.
