Thank you for agreeing to be interviewed by a student for the 2005 Association for Women in Mathematics Essay Contest!

We have asked students to make this information page available to their interviewees.

The purpose of the AWM Essay Contest is to increase awareness of women's ongoing contributions to the mathematical sciences. To participate, students must interview a woman currently working in a mathematical career, then write and submit an essay about her based on that interview. What constitutes a mathematical career is defined by the interviewee, but certainly includes math teachers of all levels, scientists making use of mathematics in their work, and other careers that rely on mathematical knowledge.

The contest is open to students in the following categories: Grades 6 - 8, Grades 9 - 12, and College Undergraduates. At least one winning entry will be chosen from each category. The winners receive a prize, and their essays will be published online at the AWM web site. Additionally, a grand prize winner will have his or her entry published in the AWM Newsletter.

Should the essay about you be chosen as a winner, you will have an opportunity to check the essay for factual errors before publication. If you would not be comfortable having an essay about you published on the web page or in the AWM Newsletter

(we can use pseudonyms when requested by the interviewee)
please let the student know.

In order to submit their essay, students must complete an online submission form. Please provide the student with the following information so they can include accurate contact information for you in their online submission. Note that the red items are required. And the student is required to provide as least one of the other three items (preferably more than one). If the student's essay is selected as a winner, we must be able to contact you. (We will not share your contact information with anyone.)
